PRESIDENT: Motion fails. There's a motion by Senator Goodrich to raise the Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I've got a motion on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, motion on the desk. I move to indefinitely postpone 368.

PRESIDENT: That shall lay over one day under the new rules.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 74. Is 368A laid over?

CLERK: Yeah, it follows 368.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 74.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion? The question is the adoption of amendments to 74. All those in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, there's a series of amendments on LB 74. The first one is offered by Senator Keyes. The amendment is set out in full in the Journal on page 1334. Senator Keyes is not present.

PRESIDENT: The question is what shall we do with the amendments to LB . . . the specific amendments to LB 74. Are you ready to vote? Nobody's . . . Senator Burbach.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move we pass over 74 and leave it in the spot that it is because of the absence of the introducer of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: You're asking unanimous consent Senator? Is there an objection to the request for unanimous consent? Seeing none, it's so ordered. Thank you Senator. We move from Select File. Senator George has asked the Chair to announce that in the South balcony there are some 27 students, 11th and 12th grade high school students, from Walthill, Nebraska. Welcome to the Legislature. Nice to have you here.

We go to General File. LB 187.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 187 was considered yesterday. The committee amendments were adopted. There is an amendment by Senator DeCamp. The DeCamp amendment was adopted. Some other amendments were withdrawn. There is now a motion to indefinitely postpone LB 187. Signed, Senator Koch.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Koch.
