PRESIDENT: Motion carries.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hasebroock asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal to 235.

Mr. President, Senator Cal Carsten asked to be excused at three. Senator Mahoney asked to be excused for the balance of the afternoon.

The Appropriations Committee sends LB 69 to General File as amended. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Burbach.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, on your calendar you will see 32-5050A and 235. The chairman of the committee asked me to lay these over for a couple more days. If you did not visit with him yesterday he was absent. So they are on your calendar, but in place of those we're going to take up some budget bills now, LB 598, 551, 472 and 550 in that order.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read title to 598. There are no committee amendments or other amendments.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 598 be advanced to E & R initial. This bill, which includes several pages, comes as a result of the Attorney General's opinion which says that on most funds you have to have . . . I'm talking about cash funds, you have to have the exact amount. This is a change of opinion since the last budget was enacted. In order to be fair to the departments and live up to the Attorney General's opinion we have to increase the Insurance Department cash fund \$36,000; Economic Development \$10,000; Education \$18,000; Welfare \$1,550,000; Corrections \$439,670; State Colleges \$412,952. If you look at the fiscal note you will see that it's over \$2,400,000 of cash and \$207,000 in the revolving fund that these funds are increased. This does not cost any general fund money. This comes about as the opinion from the Attorney General. So, unless there are questions, I renew the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion? The question is the advancement of LB 598. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Read title of LB 551.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 551 be advanced to E & R initial. This is a bill that costs \$2,208,637.00 and appropriates a salary for the Supreme Court, the clerk, the reporter, 45 other judges, the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Attorney General, State Treasurer, the five Public Service Commissioners, and the Tax Commissioner.
