CLERK: Senator Bereuter voting aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach aye on the original motion. Record your presence please. Would the Sergeant-at-Arms secure the presence . . . Senator Mills voting aye. Changing from no to yea.

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald voting aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I move the Call be raised.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Are there further amendments on the desk? Mr. President, I move that LB 114 be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall 114 be advanced as amended. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Read title to LB 115. There are committee amendments by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee, and there are amendments offered by Senator Warner which is as follows: "In lieu of the standing committee amendment insert the following". Those amendments are found on page 1236 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd . . . you want me to move to reject the committee amendments, or can I make one motion to substitute this for the committee amendments?

PRESIDENT: We've been rejecting, then moving subsequently.

SENATOR WARNER: Alright. Mr. President, I move the committee amendment be rejected then.

PRESIDENT: Alright that is the question.

SENATOR WARNER: Let me clarify it just a moment. The amendment I'm offering in lieu of it is substantially the same as the committee amendment. It was the . . . the committee amendment was adopted in committee knowing that it needed to have some change made. My substitute motion is not substantively different than the committee amendment.
