LB74, 430, 307

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I was going to ask the same thing Mr. President, I would just like to have it bracketed until next Wednesday.

PRESIDENT: OK, there is a motion to bracket 430 until next week. Senator Lewis, that is a little bit specific, but it is not to a time uncertain, could you specify a date? Oh, Wednesday, I didn't hear that. OK, until Wednesday of next week. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This is a bill which I introduced and I understand what the motion is and I suggest that you adopt this motion to bracket it and by letting the movers know that it doesn't bother me in the least to bracket it to whenever they say, whatever they want to do with it, I hope to take the cream off whatever it is you put cream on top of, but I want to take the sting out of what they were trying to do. On any of my bills members of the Legislature, you can do whatever you please because sometimes we have to serve a therapeutic function for our colleagues, and if 430 can do that today, if it can settle minds, if it can take some of the vinegar out of the grudges, if it can do anything that is going to make everybody feel better today I am happy that I have a bill that can serve this function today. PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: About all I can say is Amen to that, because I had one awhile ago that they were doing the same thing with. So I feel as if maybe we have both had the same kind of treatment and Senator Barnett, congratulations.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall this bill be bracketed until Wednesday of next week. Record your vote. Please vote. Dr. Duis. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes.

PRESIDENT: The bill is bracketed until Wednesday of next week.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to unbracket 307 on Final Reading by Senator Marvel and after thereto, there will be a motion to return it to Select File. First request is to unbracket 307.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, your request to unbracket 307.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes, I ask unanimous consent that innocent bill that has been so maligned be unbracketed now.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is unbracketed. It is now on Select File.

CLERK: No, it is on Final Reading Mr. President.
