to do this. We have two projects in our area which are contingent on this, the passage of this bill. One has to do with the city and school board entering into a swimming pool project. The other has to do with leasing land that has a longer period than two years. I move that we advance LB 150.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk would you read . . .

CLERK: Read title. There are no committee amendments. There is an amendment by Senator Nichol to add the emergency clause. (mic inactivated)

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I move the Call be raised.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 5 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised. You moved the advancement of the bill with the emergency clause.

CLERK: No, Mr. President. He moves to amend the bill by adding the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: Alright. That's the question before us. Shall the emergency clause be attached. Any discussion? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The emergency clause is attached. Now you move that the bill be advanced? Any discussion? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That was 3 minutes and 20 seconds Senator Nichol. Senator Mahoney could you approach the microphone. Shall it be 9 or 10 o'clock?

CLERK: Mr. President, a Reference Committee report. LB 602 has been referred both to Banking and Public Health Committee. Signed, Senator Mahoney.

Notice of committee hearing. They have set the bill for May 5th at 7:30 in the Legislative Council Hearing Room. Signed, Senator Murphy.

PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I would say 9 o'clock.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to adjourn until 9 o'clock Monday. All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. We are adjourned.
