PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer by our guest chaplain, Rev. Norman Smitheram.

REV. SMITHERAM: Let us unite our hearts in prayer.  
Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Richard Lewis asks to be excused until he arrives and Senator Mahoney asked to be excused Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday.

PRESIDENT: Please record your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Corrections read. See Page 1469, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Are there further corrections from the floor? If there are none, the correction mentioned by the Clerk will stand, as will the Journal. Committee hearings and reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Retirement to whom was referred LB 189 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended. Signed Senator Hasebroock, Chairman. Mr. President, we have received a communication from the state of Mississippi forwarding to us a copy of their House Concurrent Resolution No. 31 wherein it is urged that the United States Constitution be amended to provide that the Congress shall not appropriate money in excess of their receipts. The Resolution will be on file in my office. Mr. President, we have received a copy of a Resolution from the Thurston County Clerk forwarding a copy of the Thurston County Board of Supervisors urging the Legislature to take action dealing with retro-session of criminal jurisdiction over Indians in the Winnebago Tribe. It will be on file in my office. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: Mr. President, I would like to be excused Tuesday and Wednesday of this week.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Skarda. Anything further, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: We move to Final Reading. We only have two bills, apparently. 371 and 418. Both of them require the emergency clause and we do not have an abundance of Senators here. Mr. Clerk, would you please read for the final time LB 371 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a motion printed on Page 1426 of the Legislative Journal to LB 371, a request of Senator Savage. It is my understanding at this time that
