as I said is 3 1/2% increase in their salary. I know that there has been some derogative publicity in the past year. As I said in committee I do not take this article too seriously. I have known these men for several years and I have worked with some of them on various occasions and know them to be dedicated gentlemen whose wisdom and judgment on decisions would not be affected by a few courtesies shown them for their service to the public. Now the fact of salary, I do not know how much time they spend there, however they can not have any other source of income. We know what the salary is when we came here. But we can take another source of income and I imagine that were getting better pay than they are for the time we put in here in the Legislature. I think that they put in more time so I don't believe, I can see no justification in not adding a 3 1/2% increase in their salaries when it will not take affect until 1977. So I urge the advancement of this bill.

SENATOR MOYLAN. Well I think that I have reason to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five hands, a Call of the House a has been asked for. Seeing five hands the question is shall the House go under call. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 8 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The House is under call. Indicate your presence. Thirty-four members are present Mr. Sergeant at Arms. Chair recognizes Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, I would ask for a roll call vote on this issue.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 22 ayes, 19 nays and 8 not voting. Vote appears on page 1505-1506 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The bill is not advanced. It remains on General File. We pick up now LB 340. Motion made to raise the Call. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: The Call has been raised. LB340.

CLERK: Read LB340.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature the committee amendment simply changes the word item to the word size in regards to the unit that will be used to report the prices that the distributors are reporting to the Nebraska Liquor Commission. This is an amendment that
