PRESIDENT: Well, it is a matter of record now, I think, or you have not made the motion. All right. Then you are now making that motion. Yes. That will be part of the record. OK.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a motion to introduce... Request #858 from the Appropriations Committee. It is a bill for an act to make appropriations to the Legislative Council for the period of July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976, and to declare an emergency.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: This is the fourth of the Appropriations bills and I...and this has to do with the Legislative Council. I move the introduction of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, the granting of Request #858? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries.

CLERK: Whoops! Let me read the bill. LB 606, introduced by the Appropriations Committee and signed by the members thereof. Read title. See Page 1530, Journal. Mr. President, I move that the Rules be suspended and LB 606 be placed on General File without a public hearing. 606.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. The motion is to suspend the same rules, under Rule 3, that we did earlier. Any discussion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails and the bill will be put on General File without hearing. The question is, shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays. Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move we reconsider our action in the override attempt on LB 267/ Signed Senator Chambers. I believe he wanted to lay that over.
