PRESIDENT: Further discussion of Senator Luedtke's amendment? The question is the adoption of that amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 298 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 599.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion? The question is the adoption of amendments to 599. All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 599 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The bill is advanced. Senator Koch, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KOCH: Point of information, Mr. President. Are we still on Select File?

PRESIDENT: We think that 368A is still here.

SENATOR KOCH: It's still there. That's my purpose of rising to the question.

PRESIDENT: Vince, 368A?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 368A has no E & R amendments. The bill was considered yesterday and failed to advance.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, members of the body, I move that we advance 368A. I would hope that you fully understand and comprehend the importance of this piece of legislation. I urge all of you to support it on its passage.

PRESIDENT: Further discussion? Senator Frank Lewis. The Chair will . . . Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, members of the body, I'm certain that my fellow Senators understand the bill. I don't think it needs any discussion. It's just a matter of voting. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: It will be a machine vote. Record your vote. Please vote. Have you voted? Record. Senator Koch.
