Building they don't take voluminous records with them. At the bottom of Page 12, we are talking about DAS and the development of a cooperative study on life and health insurance. We have some departments whose employees get \$150 a year. The University gets \$240. State Colleges get \$180 and you will find on Page 13 about six different items in regard to analyzing this important area. On Page 14, we are talking about the material division which includes purchasing, the Transportation Services Bureau, the operation of stores, et cetera. At the bottom of the page, one of the most important areas in the Department of Administrative Services, central data processing which operates under a cash fund. It has about 150 employees. The Budget Division which is under DAS, part of the Governor's staff of 12 people. The Department of Planning and Programming which has about 24 people involved here. On the top of Page 16, another division of DAS, Central Buildings and Grounds Division, which includes the keeping of lands, operation of utilities, janitorial service and the operation of the division as far as new buildings is concerned and you will find on Page 16, line 12 where you have \$120,000 of General Funds earmarked. On page 19, we are talking about the Department of Economic Development. I think, Mr. President, I, basically, unless there is some specific questions, covered the important items.
