CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting aye on the original motion. Senator Anderson voting aye on the original motion. Senator Nichol voting aye. Senator Duis voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Based on my count, that is 25.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch voting no.

CLERK: Senator Koch voting no.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Based on that, I will move the Call be raised.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Call be raised? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 19 nays.
