CLERK: Mr. President, your committee, Enrollment and Review, reports we have examined and reviewed LB 123 and find the same . . . should be placed on Select File as amended; 141 Select File as amended; 215 Select File; 605 Select File as amended; 609 Select File; and 571 Select File as amended; and 571A Select File as amended. Signed, Senator Dworak, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: That's with the concurrence of the Speaker. I think that . . . we don't have 25 people here, Senator Burbach. I don't think there's anything we can do, unless you want to advance LB 237 without any discussion.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. The other day I referred to Senator Keyes as being a brilliant man, but sometimes was a little off in that particular instance. He agreed that he was. In this instance, to reverse myself and think that Senator Barnett is sometimes correct.

PRESIDENT: Well, let's. They might get back by that time. Why don't we try to reconvene then sharply at 2 o'clock.

SPEAKER: Is Senator Dworak here to make the motion?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SPEAKER: I would move we would proceed with this.

PRESIDENT: Then we'll go to Select File. Alright, let's do what we can.

CLERK: Alright the first one would be, Mr. President, LB 123. There are E & R amendments.
