SENATOR KREMER: There are about 43,000 irrigation wells powered by a power system in Nebraska and it would not be possible for me to tell you how many are on natural gas. In my area I would imagine that 3/4 of them are on natural gas. Now this may not hold true across the state.

SENATOR NICHOL: My question Senator Kremer is, and I don't want to be a nuisance to you, but I was just wondering if we were qualified to tell the federal government or the people who do know what the quantities of gas that we have available for the next several years as to what route we should take.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the resolution. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays and 21 not voting.

I'll pass this around and it has the names on it and I'll have the list or these people telling what time they are to leave. I have been talking to Senator Burbach about this just now and that is why he is trying to change the schedule on this a little bit because there is no way that we can get these flights in any other way except to go from 11:30 to 1:30 which is a two hour flight. I'm working with the Guard right now to find out how your going to travel out there. I would assume that it would be in car instead of bus, because it is a little faster and there will be a flight at approximately 5:00 and there may be room for about one or two more people, but you would have to come and see me right away because we have to give them the numbers that we need to have go. I have got about 18 at 11:30, not 18 Senators, there are a couple reporters and there is about 8 to 10 leaving at 5:00 and Vince I talked to you about 5:00 and we'll talk to you later. If you want to come and talk to me about this, let me know right away because I have a call into the Colonel right now.
