PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendment. Any discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The amendments to 598 are adopted.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB598 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Discussion? Question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye, those contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Recognize Senator Moylan and see if he wants to take that one up.

SENATOR MOYLAN: (mike not activated)

PRESIDENT: Do you want to take up 311? Senator Duis, if they have amendments were not taking them up Senator Duis. For the student visitors, we have many of our membership go to Omaha to see the tornado damage so we don't have enough members here to transact highly controversial business so were trying to move some non-controversial business along. That is why you see such a causal attitude around. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I believe that 599 is bracketed up there on E & R with amendments that I have offered to it. Would it be in order to ask by unanimous consent to unbracket it to withdraw the amendment?

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection to Senator Murphys unbracketing 599? Seeing none, it is so ordered. 599, now Senator Murphy, you withdraw your amendments?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: It is so ordered. Do you want to make the motion.

SENATOR MURPHY: I would move to advance the bill to E & R for engrossment final.

PRESIDENT: It is there the Clerk says.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB599 is already on E & R for Engrossing and we'll just proceed.

PRESIDENT: Let the record show that Senator Murphy withdraws his motion to advance.

CLERK: That is about all Mr. President. Mr. President LB368 was returned by Senator Duis by a machine vote for a specific amendment. The specific amendment was never considered. It is pending before the Legislature and it is found on page 1662 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Duis.
