PRESIDENT: Well we've had debate on all of them. Senator Duis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DUIS: I believe, sir, that if you divide the question, it must be divided in its entirety and cannot be divided the way you say. Division of the question is a real difficult situation in the Rule Book because you have to argue both situations: the division of the question, the divided questions and the question as a whole.

SENATOR MARVEL: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I can help on this. Vince, you have a sheet that's got six subdivisions. Right? One and two have to do with the Game and Parks Commission and the money ear-marked for automobiles as per LB 474. Three, four and five are the ones that have to do with the Department of Agriculture raising a cash fund for the Wheat Commission. The one that Senator Goodrich is interested in is number six. If you want to divide the question one and two have to do with the Game Commission; three, four and five have to do with the Wheat Commission; number six has to do with the Cavanaugh amendment. I make a motion then, Mr. President, that on my amendment to 603 that one, two, three, four and five be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. The question is the adoption ... the question is the adoption of paragraphs one, two, three, four, five of the Marvel amendment. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: OK, now I move that number six be adopted, which is the one we've been arguing about.

PRESIDENT: Alright, you've heard the question, the adoption of paragraph six. Record your vote. Please vote. Would you please vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays.

PRESIDENT: The entire motion is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, considering the length of this bill I'll interrupt and advise you that the Governor has received LB 50 and 50A, which bills were signed by him on May 8, 1975 and delivered to the Secretary of State.

Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senator Marvel. It is a computer print-out identified as request number 867.
