Senator Frank Lewis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Leiwis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Is this the corrective amendment I just gave you, Vince?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, at the request of the fiscal staff, with some of the amendments we have made in regard to the state colleges, we had to place the totals down and make the necessary technical readjustments. This is technical readjustment to that particular bill. The fiscal staff says it should be done this way. I am asking you to do it that way. That's all the debate. I am through.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further debate? The question is, the adoption of Senator Frank Lewis amendment? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: (Mike off) I move that 610 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor say aye. Contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have some reports to read in. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 605 and find the same correctly engrossed. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 508 and recommend that it be replaced on Select File as amended; LB 74 replaced on Select File as amended; LB 212 replaced on Select File as amended; LB 468 replaced on Select File as amended; LB 404 replaced on Select File as amended; and LB 416 replaced on Select File as amended.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I think I had some other amendments on 610.

PRESIDENT: You can move to return it.

CLERK: We don't have any more amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: There is one on the Field House.
