CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill, LB 237A introduced by Senator Barnett. Read title. See Page 1798, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: (Mike off)

PRESIDENT: There is nothing on the desk is the explanation.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: So there will be no consideration of that amendment.

PRESIDENT: There is nothing here to consider.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Well, it was placed on the desk.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk says not.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: So I am a liar and the Clerk isn't.

PRESIDENT: No, there is nothing on the desk. Senator Dworak. Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Yes, I will take care of it. Where are the bills that we are suppose to take up. Lead me into this and I will handle it. Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 508.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary no. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 508 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The request is the advancement of 508. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments on LB 74.

PRESIDENT: 704?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: 704 or 74, Vince?

PRESIDENT: 74. The E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I then move that LB 74 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Any discussion? All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 212.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The amendments are adopted.
