SENATOR R. LEWIS: MR. President, members of the Legislature. I don't especially care to speak to returning the bill, however I do plan to give Senator Schmit a vote but I would like to endorse and say that I agree with his observation as to the way the University is handling their priorities. I think that Agriculture has gotten whipped around on this particular thing. I think that the appropriation committee probably didn't have any choice in the manner in which they handled it, but I think that they have probably got some cheaper projects authorized knowing full well that some of us would come in and make an effort to fund some of the programs that we give a high priority and I don't agree with this type of funding procedures and I certainly plan to support Senator Schmit on this particular issue.

PRESIDENT: The question then is the return of the bill for a specific amendment. Record your vote. Please vote promptly on this matter. Have you voted? Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays and 16 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I move the adoption of the amendment. The total amount of money is \$74,085.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 5 nays and 17 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move the bill be re-advanced.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the question. All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. A machine vote on the advancement of the bill. Question is shall the bill be advanced. Well the Chair couldn't determine from the voice vote. Record

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB611 to Select File, signed, Senator Koch. Read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Koch.
