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with newspapers and which paper are they going to advertise in? I know that it will be too expensive for them to advertise in the eight papers and if they choose one paper the people in that particular area are going to get the results of their meetings but the other people are not going too. I would certainly hate to see them divert the money to...from their projects to go to all of their papers. Unless you can treat all of the papers the same, I think that we are starting something here that we might not see any end of. Senator Schmit I am going to have to oppose you this time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I certainly think that there is a misunderstanding of what Senator Schmit's amendment is doing. It is going to allow the NRD's to publish at most reasonable cost that they can afford to do it where the cost to the tax payers will not be a burden, it is going to reduce it to the NRD's and make a real practical solution to the problem. The amendment is not going to increase the cost to the NRD's it is going to reduce it. I think that there is a total misunderstanding as to what this amendment Senator Schmit has is doing. It is reducing the cost of publishing to the NRD's not increasing it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Well, Mr. President, I was going to say about what Senator Burrows has said we are not talking about the bill, the bill has already been adopted. Senator Schmit has offered an amendment to clarify the rates for the cost of publication. I think the bill as it now stands is a compromise between Senator Schmit and the Ag Committee and the NRD's across the state and to Senator Syas I would say which is I think is the same as his from the Papio NRD from whom I have some major differences but they are in agreement with the provisions of this bill. They are perfectly willing to publish their monthly proceedings as required in this bill. I move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: The question is whether debate shall cease. There is only one other light on. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes and 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Debate shall cease. Senator Schmit, do you have any reply on your amendment, on return of it?

SENATOR SCHMIT: All I can say, Mr. President, is that this amendment will reduce the cost if the bill is finally passed.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt...to return the bill for the amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Clerk record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, no nays on motion to return.

PRESIDENT: 404 is returned to Select File. Senator Schmit, what shall we do with the amendment?
