SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, LB 613 is the bill that we are taking, and with the counsel of our bill drafter, we can take 613 and place it into 612 by this manner. You have all received within the last day a copy of the Federal Disaster law that we have to pass so that the people who are in the tornado zone can become part and parcel of the program the federal government has passed since our original 1974 Disaster law. So the Relief Act, which is Public Law 93-288 would be taken in in respect to this law here and I am asking that LB 613, which sits on General File, be place over into 612 as it is today, that bill and that bill only. It covers the subject matter which the gentleman was here from the Council of State Governments and did talk to many of you and almost all of you concerning why Nebraska had to make these changes so that the tornado victims and the people who had the homes could be eligible.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Mahoney, your amendment actually drafts 613 as it was drafted and introduced into 612?

SENATOR MAHONEY: That's correct.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK. I have an amendment on the desk to that that we should adopt just prior to the...I want to amend the Mahoney amendment, in other words.

SPEAKER: Do you have the amendment, Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR GOODRICH: You got that amendment on 613. Have you got it now, Vince?

SPEAKER: It will be just a second. They are checking through to find it.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK. I gave it to you this morning.

CLERK: To amend LB 613, on Page 13, strike the sentence beginning on line 11.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK. Now what this is, this is an amendment to 613. Since we are transferring 613 into 612, we adopt this amendment to this Mahoney amendment and we are OK. The sentence I am referring to is on Page 13 of LB 613 starting with line 11 through 14.

CLERK: What's the section on it, Senator, because the Mahoney amendment doesn't jibe. On Page 13, there is nothing but the bill title.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Section 7. It is section 7. The last sentence on section 7 of the Mahoney amendment. Have you got a section 7 in the Mahoney amendment?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR GOODRICH: And at the last sentence in that, for the purposes of this subsection...the last sentence in that section.
