took care of the ditches, also. Naturally I wouldn't stand up here and say, you can't shoot from the road but you still can from the ditches. I accepted what I thought the intent of the DeCamp amendment was. Now concerning your amendment, I think you got what you wanted out of the bill. I don't know why, if you are going to go this far, why you don't prevent all hunting from the road and ditches. That would be all right with me. I really would. I will accept that. Go all the way. Keep these people from hunting jack rabbits, raccoons and everything from the road. What's wrong with that?

SPEAKER: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I just wanted to confirm that I was first under the impression that the DeCamp amendment was the same as mine and I just checked back on the statute books and it is not. Section 36-602 simply means the surface of the road, no ditches, no right-of-way. Therefore, I would support Senator Warner's amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I agree with Senator Syas that if we are going to stop hunting from the road with a shotgun and buckshot and still allow high powered rifles on the road, there is no consistency in that, and that if the Warner amendment is adopted, it should be included to stop all hunting from the road.

SPEAKER: Senator Warner, second time.

SENATOR WARNER: Am I on.

SPEAKER: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: I want to repeat one more time. We are not talking about anything different than we did... what we thought we were talking about with the DeCamp amendment. There is absolutely no change from what was involved then. Now if you concur with what was done on the DeCamp amendment, then you should have no objection to adopting this one or else you can adopt Senator George's amendment up there and strike the word "migratory" again and then we are at the same place where I think many of us thought we were a few minutes ago.

SPEAKER: Senator Syas, second time.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, the intent, I think, this time of Senator Warner is honorable. I will concede the point and let him have this, as far as I'm concerned. Let him have the amendment, if that will help pass the bill. My main idea is to get the dove bill through and I will have to take some restrictions but I never did intend to allow dove hunting from the road and I was assuming that that included the ditches.

SPEAKER: No further discussion? The motion is, to adopt the Warner amendment. All in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk shall record.
