PRESIDENT: The question is, shall we be in recess until 1:30 p.m.? All those in favor say aye. Contrary no. We are in recess until 1:30 p.m.

RECESS

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order. Would you record your presence?

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are on Final Reading. All Senators, please take your chairs and all non-senatorial personnel leave the floor of the Legislature. Commence reading the bill, Mr. Clerk. That is 598.

(RECORDER TURNED OFF FOR FINAL READING OF LB 598.)

PRESIDENT: (Mike off) requires that a bill be read in its entirety but debate and other considerations are not allowed by the Constitution so that is why you saw so much inactivity on the floor. Thank you for coming.
