CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LP 123 for Select File to attach a specific amendment. This is Senator DeCamp's amendment. On page insert a new section to read as follows: (Read amendment found on pages 1863 and 1869 of Journal).

PRESIDENT: In this discussion this morning I believe it was decided that someone would attempt to carry this amendment for Senator DeCamp. Senator Syas. Senator Warner are you carrying the amendment for . . .

SENATOR WARNER: Well I see the Speaker is on his feet To dispose of the matter I'll move its adoption. But I don't know . . . I'd like to . . . prefer it for the Speaker to give his direction.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER: Well according to our decision here this morning we were going to take it up immediately after the decision on LB 598. So now is the time to take it up.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion?

SENATOR SYAS: Are you talking about the amendment or the bill?

PRESIDENT: The amendment, the DeCamp amendment to 123. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I don't want to prolong this, but I don't think you can tie one bill to another bill like he's trying to do. I think it's rather on the goofy side.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Well Mr. Speaker would it be possible for me to make the motion that we advance the bill and then talk against it, or would it be just as well to leave it set like it is?

PRESIDENT: Yeah. The bill has already been advanced, Senator. Now the motion is to return it for the specific amendment.

SENATOR KEYES: Well if there's nobody going to move that we return it, I move we read the bill.

PRESIDENT: No it's been moved. The motion is on the desk. The motion is to return it to Select File. That's the matter that we're going to vote on. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I thank you for giving me the opportunity to close. I think the members understand the issue.
