SENATOR LEWIS: (Mike off) is absolutely correct. I move previous motion...previous question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five seconds. All right. The question is, shall debate cease on this matter? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. Senator Duis, will you close?

SENATOR DUIS: Very briefly, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I ask you to vote in the affirmative on this motion and then we can delve into the situations that come up regarding the percentages of the income tax and all the rest of it. What happened here is that the Governor brought over a bill for introduction here and I attempted to put it right back in the position that he had it in when he brought it over here. I think he probably knew what he was doing when he was bringing it over here but apparently there is some thought as to whether or not that position was correct regarding the sales tax, so therefore, I ask to withdraw this motion so that we can start over, and if at another time, with intervening business, someone else wants to introduce it they certainly have the privilege but I provoked the discussion so I ask that it be withdrawn and we proceed with the discussion of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall Senator Duis withdraw his motion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 14 nays on motion to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: Motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are some more amendments. May I read in some reports?

PRESIDENT: Yes, read some reports in.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 123 and 598 and find the same correctly enrolled. Signed Don Dworak, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I have signed LB 123. Under the same circumstances, LB 598.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined LB 237A and recommend it be placed on Select File; 237 Select File; 142 Select File; and 325 Select File as amended. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, there was delivered to the Governor all the bills passed this morning. Signed Barbara Jackson, Enrolling Clerk. That is all, Mr. President. There is now pending a motion by Senator Warner on LB 589, Amend page 6, line 10, strike "13" and insert "twelve". Signed Senator Warner.
