SENATOR KEYES: Alright, a question of the Speaker. Mr. Speaker, is 123 going to be expedited tonight just like all of the bills passed today?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: (mic inactivated) . . . Burnett whose office handles the delivery to the Governor. I don't even know if the Governors office is open at this point.

SENATOR KEYES: But the bills will be expedited right over there, just like all other bills. I don't see any reason why Senator Burbach should have the privilege of changing this bill from any other bill. So I will withdraw my motion, but watch out Senator Burbach what you're trying to do.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, if that's the case I think any Senator on this floor has the same prerogative. I therefore would ask consent to hold LB 603 for reconsideration.

CLERK: I think, Mr. President, 603 has already been delivered to the Governor.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Clerk advises me that 603 has been delivered to the Governor, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Then I would request the Clerk to return it from the Governors office.

SENATOR SAVAGE: There has been a request by Senator Koch to return the bill to . . .

CLERK: We have to vote to ask the Governor to return it. We can't just go get them.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Is your motion to ask the Governor to return the bill, Senator Koch?

SENATOR KOCH: My motion is that the Clerk notify the Governor I request return of 603.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Is there any discussion on this motion? The question is to request the Governor to return . . . There's nothing before the House except Senator Koch's motion. The motion is . . . Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Then I assume the Speaker withdrew his request on 123?

CLERK: No, you objected.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Is the condition is, if the bill's going to be withheld, but you have to have a vote on it. If it's not, send it over.

SPEAKER: I so move that LB 123 be held over for further discussion tomorrow morning.
