SENATOR KIME: Mr. Chairman, and members of the body, this bill which comes up every year and has to do with certain claims against the state, which the state claims board has recommended to be allowed. Claims committee has heard these claims and concurs with the findings of the Claims Board. I'll go with the committee amendments. Number one on page two, claims against the Department of Agriculture Firestone Store from the General Fund \$78.57. Claim number four against the Department of Agriculture to Kirk Motors \$25.69. Claim number twelve the Board of Trustees the Nebraska College, \$72.00. Claim thirteen against the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State College to John Schneider, \$22.60. Claim 90, the Department of Roads to J. F. Meyer \$5,020. Claim 117, the Secretary of State pays to the Nebraska Press Advertising Service, \$195,535.05. Payment of check District Court Dodge County at Fremont a judgment of Sandra Hanson, the State of Nebraska out of the general fund \$76,000. I move that the bill be advanced to General File and expedited.

PRESIDENT: Don't we have the amendments to adopt first Senator.

SENATOR KIME; I move the adoption of these amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. President, sorry for not being here, I was on the phone. There are additional amendments that I would like to see adopted. I imagine that we should take those after the committee amendments are adopted. I think that it is very important that we get this bill expedited because there is quite an outstanding debt to be paid to the Nebraska Press Assoc. for printing the ballots and I think it is \$197,000 so I hope that we do not delay on this bill and get it on the way.
