PRESIDENT: Well now Senator, your motion is to take it up.

SENATOR BEREUTER: That's correct.

PRESIDENT: Do we vote on whether to take it up or not?

SENATOR BEREUTER: I ask unanimous consent to take it up at this time.

PRESIDENT: Alright, is there an objection to taking this bill up on General File? There is.

SENATOR BEREUTER: I move that we take LB 213 up for consideration at this time.

PRESIDENT: Alright, OK. Chair recognizes Senator Richard Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, I don't have any particular objection but didn't this fail to get the necessary votes to move it the other day? Did that put it at the bottom of General File then?

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, this bill failed to advance after debate the last time. Your question is does this go to the bottom General File?

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Well Senator Bereuter has made a motion that it be considered at this time. So the matter that's under discussion is Senator Bereuter's motion to debate the bill again.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Well then I have another question. Any other bill being considered, even on this Select File, if they fail to get the necessary majority do they stay in that position?

PRESIDENT: They would unless the Legislature would change its mind.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: OK.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is shall LB 213 be taken under consideration at this time. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays.

PRESIDENT: We shall take up LB 213. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read title to LB 213. The bill has been considered before. The committee amendments were adopted. An amendment offered by Senator Bereuter was adopted at which time the bill failed to advance. There are now additional amendments offered by Senator George.
