SENATOR MARVEL: I move that the bill be readvanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on your desk. Mr. President, I move to return 571A to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed Senator Dworak.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak, do you ask to withdraw that?

SENATOR DWORAK: I'd ask unanimous consent to withdraw that. That was put in a couple weeks ago.

PRESIDENT: Seeing no objection, it's withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return 203 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed Senator DeCamp. The specific amendment is on the Standing Committee amendment to LB 203 Journal page 1421, strike sections 3, 4 and 9. Renumber sections 5 to 8 as sections 3 to 6, respectively.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, this is a technical correction. The error was apparently made by the Committee Clerk or someone along the line. Senator Burbach knows about it and I think he's in agreement with it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Senator DeCamp explained to me yesterday evening and it was also discussed to some degree on the floor. We did strike one amendment which I offered and this did not do the entire thing. Senator DeCamp looked it over and I agree with his amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I probably could agree with this amendment but no one has actually told us what it has done yet. I think in this particular piece of legislation, we better know.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, we'll do that. As you know the final agreed upon concept in the family farm bill was to have a reporting program to develop information. Left over from some of the other proposals were various other ideas or concepts included but not limited to the idea that corporations should be divested of their land. This concept was rejected by the Legislature and by the committee and we took out most of the language that related to that concept. This is some language left in relating to that idea. Of itself, it's not complete because the other parts were taken out. So, as I say, it's a technical correction to keep it a reporting bill.
