SENATOR F. LEWIS: I think if there were errors in the drafting that Senator Anderson can correct it. The bill was drafted, primarily, by the Division of Motor Vehicles over which the Governor has control. I would suggest he take proper administrative steps to correct the situation.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I don't know if it's appropriate to take the motion at this time, but I will make it. At the appropriate time we can act on it. I move that LB 259 and 259A be passed not withstanding the objections of the Governor.

PRESIDENT: Motion by Senator Chambers is that LB 259 and 259A be passed regardless of the action of the Governor. Shall we take them up one at a time, Vince? After Final Reading? Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Chambers indicated he didn't care to break in now and that he would do it sometime when it's more convenient and more appropriate time.

PRESIDENT: We'll hold your motion in abeyance till after Final Reading, Senator Chambers. Proceed with Final Reading. Motion is withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Read the message.

CLERK: It's a letter from the Secretary of State acknowledging receipt of LB 526 and the certificate of the same.

Mr. President, your committee, Enrollment and Review, respectfully submits that they have examined and reviewed LB 325 and recommend that the same be replaced on Select File with amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

CLERK: 325 with amendments on it.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 325.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor please say aye, opposed no. Motion carried.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 325 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.
