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tickets if each and every member of my community and each and every member of my district had the opportunity rather than those tickets being locked in for the select few. The big issue here, and Senator Warner wants to make sure there's availability to the public, this is exactly the way to do it. I've had some real good ideas in this body before but this is one of the best. This is a super one. Senator Warner I would hope that you would stand and join arms with me in support of my amendments that says that each and every person, regardless of his wealth or regardless of his status in his community or his state, can get down there and watch the team play rather than only the affluent doing so. I want to tell you how much a truly appreciate you bringing this resolution up so I could put this meritorious amendment on it which I know will be adopted by each and every Senator on behalf of the taxpayers in his district that support this University and ought to see the team play. I urge the adoption of my amendment. When you do that I urge the adoption of the Warner resolution.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I've got so many things going through now with this amendment. I've got a question of Lewis. I don't know when you made yours effective, but I've already sent in my check for my tickets. I want to know if you mean now or next year? I hope so.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Well you see, Senator Barnett, this is a resolution asking that the Regents take some particular action. The administration of the same would be up to them.

SENATOR BARNETT: Yeah, but you're amending it and I wanted to know if your amendment took effect this year or next year?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Well I want to see the democratic process take place as soon as feasible. If it takes a year to implement it, I'm patient.

SENATOR BARNETT: OK, I have two questions of the introducer of the resolution if I may Mr. President. My good friend. I have one question to start with. Do you agree with the amendment?

SENATOR WARNER: No.

SENATOR BARNETT: Can you tell me why and then I'll go on to my next question.

SENATOR WARNER: Yeah. I think I would concur with the position that those who have supported the football program or the athletic program for a good many years consistently in lean and good probably it's not unreasonable that they can renew their tickets for those seats in a given year.

SENATOR BARNETT: OK, my second question refers to LR 59 which is introduced by you, Senator Warner.
