SENATOR ANDERSON: It is a substitute for the Committee amendments.

CLERK: Okay. Then what we need is a motion to adopt. Then if it carries, then a motion to reject the Committee amendment. We have to dispose of them one way or another.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion? Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I would like to ask Senator Anderson a question.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Keyes, do you understand what we are doing? We are substituting this, in essence, for the Committee amendments. They will later be rejected, if this prevails.

SENATOR KEYES: I am just asking about his amendment right now.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Anderson, your amendment right now is going to mean then that to apply you can be charged up to \$150.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Okay, I was talking to Senator Dworak. I didn't hear the question. I am sorry.

SENATOR KEYES: You can be charged up to \$150 under this new amendment of yours?

SENATOR ANDERSON: There are two limitations that are placed on it. The original bill said \$175. Now it says, first of all, that the fee cannot exceed actual cost incurred in giving the examination, and in no case can it exceed \$100.

SENATOR KEYES: They have a fee of \$50 now, isn't it?

SENATOR ANDERSON: \$25 now.

SENATOR KEYES: \$25 now. Okay, that will be enough.

PRESIDENT: No further debate. The question is the adoption of Senator Anderson's amendment. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, 21 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: I have got a question of the Chair. With the adoption of the substitute amendment, do I need to ask to withdraw the Committee amendment?

CLERK: I think you need to move to reject the Committee amendment because no where in your amendment do you even refer to the Committee amendment.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Okay, then I will move that the Committee amendment be rejected.
