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providing it the Committees, at the suggestion of the Department, felt that it was proper to introduce this legislation.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: OK, very good. I think I'll just wait then, Senator Kremer, until we see what your disposition is. Then I may have some amendments to help smooth and clarify the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Swigart.

SENATOR SWIGART: Mr. Chairman, I rise to support Senator Maurice Kremer's bill because I think it ought to be just a matter of routine. He's talking about a very insignificant matter of a half a dozen counties that just haven't taken the initiative to provide the space. We need somebody to kind of get off their duff and to get the thing started. Here the state is saying that we're going to initiate the authority. We're going to say that counties have to do it. That's all it needs is a prod. Why it isn't difficult to obtain space big enough to take examinations such as this. I think it's a matter of routine. I think it's very proper for this to be initiated and that we ought to get it going.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: This is a bill that's going to have drivers licenses and have the place provided to Is that right, Senator Kremer? I'm just trying to come in too on the thing now. This is the place ... the bill that's going to make counties provide adequate place to give you ... take drivers license examination, etc? Is that right?

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Keyes, we're talking about the amendments and not the bill. The amendment that you just now touched upon ~~where you~~ used the word "adequate". The word "adequate", under this amendment, would be stricken and would then say "the county shall provide space".

SENATOR KEYES: Well how much do they then, Senator Kremer, ... is this going to make if LB, whatever the number happens to be, comes up? I know a Senator is going to introduce ... going to have a picture on your drivers license. Then are we going to have to setup a photo shop in the county too?

SENATOR KREMER: Are you sure that bill's going to pass?

SENATOR KEYES: I'm not sure it's going to pass, but it's going to be here. This one ought to follow it because if we demand that everybody have a photo on their license then we've got to have more than just a cubby hole to issue a license out of. We've got to have a camera and I don't know what all is going to be in there. And if ... a deal to seal it up in plastic.... You know we could be getting into quite a deal here. I don't know. I'm just asking some questions on this bill. Like I said, it's just beginning to break on me now, what all we're trying to do.
