CLERK: Mr. President, LB 409. There are committee amendments, Mr. President. This, again, is a bill that advanced off General File last year without consideration of the committee amendments by Senator Rasmussen's Government Committee. Yes, I've got a series of them. Well I got one to bracket.... I've got two motions to bracket.

Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to bracket LB 409 from Senator Cal Carsten.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection to Senator Cal Carsten's request for unanimous consent? Seeing none, it's so ordered.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 697 and 698.) That's all, Mr. President.

Mr. President, unanimous consent to unbracket LB 545. Signed, Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection to the unbracketing to 545? So ordered.

CLERK: The next bill on General File, Mr. President, would be 348.

PRESIDENT: Proceed, Mr. Clerk, with 348.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 348.) There are committee amendments by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wiltse.

SENATOR WILTSE: Mr. Chairman, this bill was entered purely as a safety bill, and pertains to automobiles. We have an amendment to amend the amendment on the bill. Do you want that presented before the bill is presented?

PRESIDENT: Ordinarily it is.

SENATOR WILTSE: Alright fine.

PRESIDENT: Whose amendment is it, Mr. Clerk?....Senator Kremer? Chair recognizes Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, there are two amendments to the committee amendments. One of them simply identifies what type of motor vehicle we're talking about. It inserts the language "a vehicle with four or more wheels". In other words, we're talking about an automobile rather than a motorcycle or anything like that. That's one amendment. The other amendment substitutes language that's used in the bill that would accommodate the wishes of Senator Wiltse in introducing the bill. It clarifies the language, is all it does, as to what we're talking about. I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.
