PRESIDENT WHELAN: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer given.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will be in order. Please record your presence. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit asks to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Have you all reported your presence? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections to the Journal? Do you have any, Mr. Clerk? The Journal shall stand. Do you have any notices?

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a report from the Lower Platte North Natural Resource District which was filed with my office only as of today which will be inserted in the Journal. See page 145. Mr. President, the Government Committee gives notice of hearings set for January 15th and 16th. Signed Senator Rasmussen, Chairman. Mr. President, we have two new bills. LB 708 introduced by Senator Savage. Read title. See page 146, Journal. LB 709 introduced by Senator Nichol of the 48th District. Read title. See page 146, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are now prepared to go to General File. According to our agenda, we commence with LB 495, Mr. Clerk. All right, you have a motion on the desk.

CLERK: Senator Swigart moves to unbracket LB 272.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, Senator Swigart moves to indefinitely postpone LB 272.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
