SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 534 be advanced to E & R for review, or Initial, excuse me. All LB 534 does is puts in a procedure so that a officer, an elected official, rather, required to file the bonds, county officials, will be given a notice prior to the time they are to take office in the event that they have not filed the bond. You recall, there was an instance in Lancaster County where an officer thought he had filed a bond, in a mixup. In any event, it was not and the office was vacated and he had to be appointed to fill the vacancy because of the technicality. This legislation which was presented to me at the request of the Governor establishes a procedure so if that bond is not filed or the official shall be noticed ten days before he takes office of need to file that bond and it would preclude a similar occurrence that occurred here in Lancaster County back in 1974 or following the 1974 election. I think it is essentially corrective in nature.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 534. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
