SENATOR F. LEWIS: Five is Omaha and they have a different system according to their law, and Class 6, as I understand it, have a different system. If you want to know the truth, I am interested in Class 3.

SENATOR MURPHY: And you live in a Class...

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Three.

SENATOR MURPHY: Three. Fine. I will try to determine that difference in Omaha. We had a couple of occasions last year when it was different in Omaha, something about tenure, and I just thought maybe I would take a look at this and see why it was different in Omaha, again.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: This is consistent. It is different in Omaha.

SENATOR MURPHY: There you go.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: And Murphy, you will love this, because it is going to save the taxpayers money, create a new image.

PRESIDENT: Senator Swigart, do you wish..all right. The question is, shall the bill move. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: LB 608 introduced by Frank Lewis at the request of the Governor.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, there is another bill that will resolve this problem at hand and we will look at that when we move the state aid bill. I move that it be indefinitely postponed.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Any discussion? The question is, shall LB 608 be indefinitely postponed? Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is indefinitely postponed. LB 613.

CLERK: LB 613 was put in by the Executive Board signed by Senator Mahoney, Chairman, and he is not present.

PRESIDENT: We will pass over this bill.

CLERK: LB 299 is by Senator Kennedy.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to take this up at this time, Senator Kennedy?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes.
