PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order. Record your presence. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp asked to be excused till he arrives.

PRESIDENT: While you're recording your presence we're happy to introduce the Chairman of the Scottsbluff County Board. Fred Lockwood is under the South balcony. Welcome to the Legislature. Thank you for coming, Commissioner.

Have you all recorded your presence? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: We have none.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections to the Journal from any member? Seeing none, the Journal shall stand.

Notice of committee hearings and reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, there will be inserted in the Legislative Journal a list of lobbyists who have registered with my office for the new year. In as much as old registrations continue through this year this is new registrations. That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Introduction of any bills, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We're ready to go on General File then, Senator. According to our agenda we commence with LB 495. I'm sorry, I had last Friday's agenda. We go to Final Reading. We have three bills on Final Reading. Our Rules require that all Senators remain in their chairs and all other personnel stay off the floor. Will the Senators kindly take your chairs. Mr. Clerk, would you read, on Final Reading, LB 30. Senator Hasebroock. Would you state that again, Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: I said LB 30 has an A bill that hasn't been introduced, but is being drawn by the Bill Drafters. This should go along the board before we consider LB 30 on Final Reading.
