revisor and they are made up into revisor bills which can be introduced either by the Executive Board Chairman or by the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. We have alternated this year. The Judiciary Committee Chairman is taking them and LB 614 is the first of the series. It merely corrects an erroneous internal reference to section 55-130 and inserts the correct reference which is 55-120 and that is all it does.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. The question is the adoption... the advancement of the bill. Record. We have a whole series of these. Could we have some Senators at their desks to vote please? We will be under Call constantly if we don't move these revisor bills across. Will you please sit in your seats for just a few minutes and we can move all these revisor bills across. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator Luedtke.

CLERK: LB 615 introduced by Senator Luedtke, Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. Read title. There are no Committee amendments or other amendments pending.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 615 be advanced to E & R Initial. This, along with the revisor's bills, merely adds a new section to section 34-902 which says that the Clerk of the Legislature shall deliver to the revisor of regulations all records and documents which pertain to the administrative rules and regulations on file in the Clerk's office. It merely gives direction so that the Clerk knows what he can do with those and this clarifies the matter.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. The question is, shall the bill be advanced? Record your vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator Luedtke.

CLERK: LB 616 introduced by Senator Luedtke, Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. Read title.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 616 be advanced to E & R Initial. LB 616 merely corrects an erroneous internal reference which was of section 8-1101 which was to subsection 11 and it should have read subsection 12 so this corrects it to read correctly subsection 12.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Any discussion. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.
