CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill. Read title to LB 765.

That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We're ready to move to Select File. We'll commence with LB 204. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 204 is a bill introduced by Senator DeCamp. The committee amendments have been adopted. Amendments offered by...

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, I would like to ask a question of Senator DeCamp about the communication which came to our desk. The communication is telling about the meeting of the Rules Committee on Thursday, January 12th. I'm guessing that means the 15th, but I would like to clarify for every Senator's information.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Typographical error. It is the 15th. It's in accordance with instructions from the Legislature, passed last session, in which the Legislature passed a resolution of Senator Frank Lewis in which they directed the Rules Committee to hold a hearing on the limits of the personal privilege used here on the floor, to give more accurate definition as to what this Legislature wants to be included, or what limitations they want imposed. That is on the 15th. We would hope that those of you who have an interest in this, ranging from the Lieutenant Governor to you, Senator Lewis, Senator Koch, some of the others who expressed an interest will appear and offer your input.

SENATOR MARSH: Each and every Senator is included in this invitation, isn't that correct.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I ask unanimous consent to bracket LB 204. Have we taken it up yet?

PRESIDENT: Alright. Is there an objection? LB 204 is bracketed.
