PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Legislature will please come to order. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kremer asked to be excused till he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes. Quorum present.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: We have none, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections to the Journal from the floor? Seeing none, the Journal shall stand.

Committee reports and hearings.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a communication addressed to Allen Beerman from Mr. Fauver, Investigation Division of the Nebraska State Patrol, advising that the ballots and ballot boxes from Scotts Bluff County were returned to Melvin Maxwell, County Clerk, County Court House, regarding the election recount. This will be inserted in the letter in full.
