SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 574.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 574 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of that motion. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary say nay.

CLERK: All right, now, Mr. President, there is pending on LB 574 a motion to kill. The proper motion would be to return it to Select File for the specific amendment to strike the enacting clause. Signed by Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: The bill has been advanced, Senator DeCamp. Would you tell us what you want to do with your motion?

SENATOR DeCAMP: I want to kill the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to return LB 574 to Select File for a specific amendment to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: We have this same situation that we have had before. Do we discuss the kill motion now on the motion to return or do we wait until we get it back? It would be very pleasant if we could avoid two arguments on the substance of the matter. Do you want to discuss your motion to return, Senator DeCamp, or just leave it as it is?

SENATOR DeCAMP: It is up to you, which ever way you want to handle it.

PRESIDENT: All right. You have heard the motion. There is a motion to return the bill to Select File for the specific amendment. Record your vote. I am sorry. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator DeCamp, did you want to make an opening statement? If he did want to make a statement, I don't want to preempt him, but if he is not going to say anything, I want to comment.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am opposed to the motion to return this bill to kill it. There was a long discussion of the bill the day that it was advanced, and for this motion to be made at this time, I think is a waste of time. I know that there has been heavy lobbying of the bill since its movement along the Board. I even received a phone call from a man in Seward, Nebraska at my house and he was trying to let me know that this is not a safe area to tread on to do the kind of things that I am trying to do.
