SENATOR BURROWS: Thank you.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I also wonder about the phrase in there "dealers in second-hand goods". You have people that deal in used furniture. Are you going to ask the people that come in to sell used furniture, to fingerprint those people? I think that we'd better give that some consideration too before we move on. I think it would be very bad to have in the statute that you would require those people be fingerprinted when they come in.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. President?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Your light was on and I... Do you wish to talk?

SENATOR KELLY: No sir, I did a little while ago.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I'm sorry. Alright the question is... Do you want to close on your amendment, Senator Burrows? There's no other lights on.

SENATOR BURROWS: I wish everyone would take note on this one. I think this is the most serious part regarding incorporating the junk dealers under this bill. I am fully in support of Senator Chambers concept of coming tight with the pawnbrokers on this legislation, as they are ... and I think it's been shown clearly, often turn out to be the fences of stolen goods. We can't regiment a group that are operating out here rural in farm machinery and equipment like that and incorporate them in the same law.

I support this bill but feel we have to make this change. I wish you'd really look at this and vote on it. It's a good bill if we clean it up just a little in the old language. Thank you.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The question now is the Burrows amendment on LB 431. All those in favor indicate by saying aye ... voting aye, those opposed nay. Senator Savage voting aye. Record.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye. 25 ayes, 0 nays, 24 not voting.

Now Mr. President, I have a request to bracket 431 until January 20th.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Goodrich, your light isn't on. I didn't....

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, it's my motion. I'll have to amend the motion to the 30th ... January 30th. Actually what I would like to do is amend it to read "until the Attorney General's opinion gets here". There's
