SENATOR SWIGART: Oh, I see, this is

SENATOR LUEDTKE: This is not the bill. You're talking about a bill that hasn't even gotten on the floor yet.

SENATOR SWIGART: Oh yes. Thank you.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Senator Luedtke, you waive closing? Question is shall the Luedtke amendment be adopted. All in favor vote aye. All opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: The amendment is adopted. Senator Luedtke, what would you do with the bill?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move that LB 584 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: All in favor say aye, all opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I was away there for a few minutes this morning because of a problem beyond my power to control. While I was gone a bill of mine was bracketed pursuant to a motion by Senator DeCamp. I don't think it's fair to have the bill bracketed in the way that he wanted. What I'm asking is unanimous consent to unbracket the bill. He wants the bill that I have on Select File held until a bill in the Judiciary Committee, and it may not get out of that Committee, is advanced from the Committee and moved across the board.

I'm asking unanimous consent to unbracket LB 432 and consider it. It was to be considered this morning.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Request for unanimous consent to unbracket LB What was that again?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: 432.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: LB 432. Does anyone object? Senator Kime objects. Senator Chambers, do you.... Senator Chambers has moved to unbracket it. All in favor vote aye, all opposed nay. Would you please vote. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I'm going to ask for a Call of the House. Then something that I didn't know, I didn't know Senator DeCamp wasn't here this morning either, so he didn't argue his motion.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Question is shall the House go under Call. All in favor vote aye, all opposed nay. The House is under Call. Please record your presence. Motion before the House is to unbracket LB 432. Please record your presence. Senator Koch.

CLERK: The motion is simply to unbracket LB 432. Senator Marsh voting aye on the original motion. Savage voting aye on the original motion. Senator Keyes voting aye on the original motion.
