PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, would you close debate on this matter please.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes. Mr. President, members of the body. Section 4, in essence, says that the sheriff shall declare an emergency and that public notice shall be given, and then he's to notify the deputies that are to serve. Then after the emergency, that he has declared, is over with he shall declare that it's over with. Then these special deputies shall no longer serve until another emergency comes along. The only time, if you do not adopt this amendment, you would have special deputies is during a declared emergency. The rest of the time you would not have any, other than ... they would be like on standby. If you want them to serve in a regular capacity you cannot have Section 4 in the bill. It's for that reason that I would encourage you to go ahead and adopt this amendment to the Chambers amendment and we'll be OK with the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Goodrich's amendment to Senator Chambers amendment. Record your vote. We're on Select File so this takes 25 votes. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment to the amendment fails.
