

SENATOR SIMPSON PRESIDING

SENATOR SIMPSON: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Have you all voted? The Clerk shall record.

CLERK: Vote read. See page 441, Journal. 38 ayes, 0 nays, remainder not voting.

SENATOR SIMPSON: The bill passed with the emergency clause attached. Now, what do you have on the desk?

CLERK: That is all, Mr. President.

SENATOR SIMPSON: We go to Select File.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 7, the first bill up, there is a motion to request to withdraw the bill.

SENATOR SIMPSON: The motion will lay over one day.

CLERK: LB 412. Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments but there are a series of other amendments. The first amendment, Mr. President, is offered by Senator DeCamp to LB 412. Mr. President, it is set out in full in the Legislative Journal on page 254.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: This is the amendment we discussed yesterday. It was just a technical correction. It gives the Commission the discretion to determine whether a license should be issued and assess costs against the loser in that case, and you will recall, we held the bill over because Senator Anderson had some amendments or something else on the bill. It wasn't held over for these. I would move these amendments be adopted. I don't think they are the part the bill was held over for.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Senator Anderson.
