CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Urban Affairs has given notice of hearings. Signed Senator Fowler.
Mr. President, an explanation of vote by Senator Kelly recording his vote as aye on LB 275.
Mr. President, Senator DeCamp offers a Rule Change. Senator George offers two Rule Changes. Mr. President, your committee on Telecommunications to whom LB 426 was referred instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File. Signed Senator Clark, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation to whom was referred LB 296 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 666 General File as amended; and LB 737 General File as amended. Signed Senator Syas, Chairman. Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day at 10:00 a.m. present to the Governor for his approval LB 329, 386, 485, 487, 569, 586, and 175. PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk, proceed with LB 7.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 7 is pending with a motion to withdraw offered by Senator Simpson.

PRESIDENT: Senator Simpson.

CLERK: The motion was made yesterday and laid over.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this bill doesn't have my name on it. Originally, it was put in as a revisor's bill. It is no longer needed in that capacity. I attempted to charge the bill to take care of some other things having to do with apartments and rental and we find that there are many problems. We can't seem to get them settled. This is too short a session to attempt to go back and do the job so I would ask that we might withdraw the bill.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall LB 7 be withdrawn? Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: The bill is withdrawn. LB 76. Excuse me, Senator Clark, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I would like to bring LB 581 back from Final Reading and put an amendment on the bill. That is a bill that is Senator Anderson's bill. It creates a cash fund out at Kearney. What I would like
