CLERK: Record vote read. See page 473, Journal. 25 ayes, 9 nays, 15 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 412 is indefinitely postponed. LB 202.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stull has a motion pending on LB 202 and I think there was a request by the Speaker to lay it over.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it will be laid over. LB 502.

CLERK: E & R amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 502.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move that LB 502 be advanced to Enrollment and Review for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Does LB 445 have amendments?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 445.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the advancement of LB 445 to E & R for engrossment.
