PRESIDENT: Senator Mills. Any further discussion? The question is the adoption of Senator Duis' amendment. Record your vote. Have you voted? Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: No further amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak. Will you advance the bill, Senator?

SENATOR DWORAK: Yes, what bill are we on?

PRESIDENT: LB 585.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the advancement of LB 585 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 460.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is an amendment offered by Senator Kelly to amend LB 460, page 11, strike lines 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, page 12, strike lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9. Signed Senator Kelly. I am sorry. The bill was replaced, Mr. President. It cannot be taken up. It has to be advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the advancement of LB 460 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR KELLY: Wait a minute. We got caught on this, 76.

PRESIDENT: This is subject to amendment now, Senator.

SENATOR KELLY: I have an amendment on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Yes. I don't think the motion to advance is in order. Isn't there a motion to...

CLERK: But the bill was replaced on Select File for E & R amendments and under the Rules that is all that can be considered.

PRESIDENT: So it has got to be brought back.

CLERK: Yes, so after we get through with the rest of them, we will come back and move to return it.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, but we were going to do that on LB 76 and we never did it.
