PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 37, 275, 440, 495, 534, 535 and 583. That's all Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: We have a new bill for introduction, Mr. President, LB 634A. Read title. Mr. President, that's all at this time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak, do you want to be recognized or is this for purpose of Select File?

SENATOR DWORAK: Select File.

PRESIDENT: Alright. We move to Select File. First bill on our agenda is LB 76. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 76 to Enrollment and Review for engrossment.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are motions on the desk here.

PRESIDENT: Read your first motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB 76 to Select File for the attached specific amendment. Signed, Senator Kelly. Senator Kelly's amendment is to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, Senator Lewis is making a request for unanimous consent to bracket. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Is he bracketing it to a day certain?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I need about another six or seven days to pickup some information. I'd bracket it until next Friday, Mr. Chairman, a week from Friday. If my memory is correct that's the 13th.

PRESIDENT: Well let's find out about that matter. Is there an objection to this request? There is an objection.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Chairman, Friday is an extremely bad day to take up, what to me 's....

PRESIDENT: Well there is an objection so that matter is done. Alright, now there's....

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'd insert Thursday, the 11th, then.

PRESIDENT: On unanimous consent.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yes, I'd....

PRESIDENT: Would you move.... I think you're going.... We might as well have a vote on it, Senator.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Well let me try it this way to appease Senator Kelly. I withdraw my original request to bracket till the 12th. Now I renew it and ask that it be bracketed until the 11th.
