PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Legislature grant Request #1444 to Senator Lewis to introduce this bill? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: Okay. Senator Mahoney voting aye. Senator Syas voting aye. Senator Schmit voting aye. That is sufficient, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Report the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays and 17 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The request is granted and the bill shall be introduced.

CLERK: LB 995 introduced by the Education Committee. Read title. See page 522, Journal.

PRESIDENT: We will now go to Select File. Do you have a motion from Senator Hasebroock?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: On LB 995, Senator Hasebroock moved to return it for a specific amendment and that specific amendment was: Read. See page 518, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, as I indicated in my reasonings for returning the bill exactly why but I will repeat it and I am reading from an Attorney General's opinion. "You have asked whether section 81-8,275 as amended by LB 635 will permit the Commission to contract for production of a limited edition of official medals. No, it will not. The amendments in LB 635 do not change the requirement of the present law that the Commission reserves the right to reorder as deemed necessary. If the phrase 'including reorders as deemed necessary' were deleted as you have suggested, the Commission will be able to contract for limited edition of the official medal" and this is exactly what we intend to do with this amendment. I move that the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion. The question is the adoption of Senator Hasebroock's amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to adopt the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 635 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Any discussion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. LB 503 on Select File.
